

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

The Handicap and Club Championships shall be run by the Match Committee appointed annually by the Club Committee.

The Match Committee shall consist of the Club Captain, Interclub Controller and no more than four other members.

The Match Committee is responsible for:

- Deciding dates and times for matches to be played.
- Compiling draws and seeding players.
- Appointing umpires if required.
- Acting as referee if necessary.
- Deciding on tournament fees.

The Match Committee shall be guided by the following:

1. Handicap and Club Championships will be held annually in Doubles, Singles and Mixed competitions.
2. Veteran's Championships will be held annually. To qualify, ladies must be 40 years or over and men 45 years or over.
3. Club Championships will normally be three tiebreaker sets. The Match Committee may vary this if necessary.
4. Approved tennis apparel must be worn for all matches.
5. All matches shall be played on the club courts at Rogers Park, Bucklands Beach.
6. All matches must be played on the date decided by the Match Committee. Requests for absences must be presented to the Match Committee at least five days prior to the scheduled match.
7. In the event of matches being interrupted by the weather, the matches must be concluded by the date set by Match Committee, or be defaulted.
8. If a player is injured during a match, 15 minutes will be given for a decision to continue the match or to default.
9. Players must be current financial members and must pay the tournament fees before commencing play.
10. Any player who is more than 15 minutes late for a match will be disqualified for that match, unless prior arrangement has been made with the Match Committee.
