RESULTS OF QUESTIONNAIRE REGARDING REPLACING THE SURFACE ON COURTS FOUR FIVE & SIX

There was overwhelming support for Astrograss to replace the surface on courts 4-6. The percentage in favour of three Astrograss courts was about 87%, with the balance split evenly between having one or two courts resurfaced with Plexipave, the remainder in Astrograss. The Management committee will now act on this information to replace the courts with the most appropriate surface.
